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Training Requirements

Theoretical and Practical Newborn Life Support/Newborn Advanced Life Support training, to be completed every **2 years** as per SA Health Perinatal Emergency Education Strategy Policy Directive. **Please ensure all online learning is undertaken through iLearn.**

Part 1 iLearn Newborn Life Support Program

The midwife, nurse or doctor is responsible for accessing and completing the Newborn Life Support Program available on the SA Health iLearn website to acquire the necessary theoretical knowledge in newborn life support.

Part 2 (Neonatal Code Blue Team and all Paediatric Medical Staff Only) iLearn Newborn Advanced Life Support Program

The midwife, nurse or doctor is responsible for accessing and completing the Newborn Advanced Life Support Program available on the iLearn website to acquire the necessary theoretical knowledge in newborn advanced life support.

Part 3

Practical Session

The midwife, nurse or doctor is responsible for booking into and completing the required practical session by booking into an NALHN iLearn practical session. Please note practical sessions will become available to book into within iLearn following completion of the required online learning.

- Newborn Life Support 1-hour practical session
- <u>Newborn Advanced Life Support (Newborn Code Blue Team and all Paediatric Medical Staff Only)</u> –
 2-hour practical session. NB: <u>This practical session includes both newborn life support and</u>
 newborn advanced life support practical sessions within the one 2-hour session.

Part 4 Presentation of Online Learning Certificates

- If participants are unable to provide evidence of completion of their pre-requisite online learning they will be unable to participate in the practical session and will require to re-book an alternate education session.
